On June 11, 2015, the Bonner County Sheriff's Office investigated the death of a 3 year old boy, who died after apparently being trapped inside an unattended vehicle along with two dogs in the 100 block of Walden Lane, Spirit Lake, Idaho.

The child was reported to be playing outside with his dogs at the residence. Preliminary investigation indicates the child's mother and her boyfriend were sleeping in the house when the boy went outside, got into the vehicle with the dogs, and apparently closed the door behind him. The child was located by his mother, who attempted lifesaving efforts.

The case remains under investigation pending the outcome of the autopsy and other details of the case. Heat exposure is suspected as the primary contributing factor in this tragic death.
