January 14, 2016 - Counterfeit Bills Arrest in Bonner County

On January 13, 2016, members of the Bonner County Sheriff's Detective Unit served a search warrant at 419 West 4th, Space #13, Clark Fork, Idaho.

A search warrant was issued based upon information gathered from an extensive ongoing investigation into the manufacturing of counterfeit money by the Bonner County Sheriff's Detectives. Upon service of the warrant, detectives found items consistent with manufacturing United States currency. Members of the United States Secret Service assisted with this investigation and the service of the search warrant.

Keith D. Snyder, 50 years old, of Clark Fork has been arrested and charged under Idaho Code §18-3601, Forgery and Counterfeiting.

Detectives believe there have been many counterfeit bills distributed throughout the Bonner County area. The majority of the cases being investigated are \$50.00 bills.
